Prairie West Terminal To Build 112 Car Siding

The Board of Directors of Prairie West Terminal Ltd. (PWT) have committed to investing in excess of \$1.5 million dollars at the high through-put grain handling facility located between the villages of Dodsland and Plenty, Saskatchewan. The project includes expansion of the existing rail siding to accommodate 112 cars and the modification of the facility's car loading equipment (the "Project"). The existing rail siding accommodates 64 cars.

The ability to load 112 car unit trains would generate an additional \$3.00 per tonne of revenue through increased railway shipping incentives. Expansion of the loading capability is a calculated move in the Company's strategic plan to increase the storage capacity at the high through-put grain handling facility. The expected completion of the Project will be late fall 2009, provided construction proceeds according to schedule.

"Shipping 112 car unit trains is clearly the direction of the entire grain handling industry is moving. PWT's investment in this project is not only going to have an effect on the business today, it also provides a solid foundation for the next 20 plus years of business" stated President, Bob Speir.

PWT expects to finance the Project either through working capital or new term debt.
